TCCD has a Local Cost Share that is 50/50. The local cost share is limited to \$780 per landowner per year and funds are limited to available funding. We assist with livestock waterers, hay/pasture seeding, lime, broadleaf, bush hogging, heavy use areas, pollinators, sinkhole repair, fencing, rotational grazing, and dead animal composting. These practices must follow state and federal guidelines where applicable.


