All livestock/animals offered for sale or exhibition at Kentucky County Fairs shall meet the following regulations according to KRS Chapter 257:

- a. 302 KAR 20:040 (Entry into Kentucky)
- b. 302 KAR 20:065 Sale and exhibition of Kentucky origin livestock in Kentucky

- 7. Weigh in begins at 4:30 p.m. All market animals must be weighed in before 5:30 p.m. Animals must be on show grounds by: 5:00 p.m.
- 8. 4-H is judged using Danish system.
- 9. Exhibitors must show their own animal unless:
 - a) Exhibitors have more than one individual animal in class
 - b) Exhibitors have more than one individual animal in championship drive.
 - c) Exhibitor has physical or mental limitations that disallow them to exhibit their own animal.
